

Snow Day and Late Start Schedules

MacArthur

If there is a delayed start, the AM session will not have class. The PM session will come to school as normal. If there is an early dismissal, the PM session will not have class.

If there is a snow emergency day, the AM session will have a class meeting at 9 AM via Teams. The PM session will have a class meeting at 1 PM. There will not be individual student meetings unless otherwise arranged.

Lincoln

Snow Days:

Remote students will have class with no changes.

Hybrid students:

- If a snow day occurs on the hybrid student's in-person day, the student will join Teams by 8:15 for a typical remote learning day according to the remote schedule we used during remote instruction.
- If a snow day occurs on the hybrid student's off day, the student will engage in Daily Tasks as if it were a typical day, so there are no changes.
- If a snow day occurs on a Wednesday, the regular remote learning schedule for Wednesdays will remain in effect, so there are no changes.

Late Start:

- Remote students will begin class at the late start time.
 - In-person students will begin school at the late start time.
 - At home learning students will enter attendance and begin Daily Tasks at the late start time.

Snow Days – No In-Person School

Remote students will have class as per their Wednesday schedule

Hybrid students:

1. Students will engage in online learning using the Wednesday online learning schedule according to the A & B Day Calendar.
2. Teachers are encouraged to take equipment (laptop, Hovercam) home that they may need to teach from home each evening in case of winter weather.
3. Teachers are allowed to come into the building to teach, but are not required or encouraged to do so, for their safety.
4. PAs will not work on Snow Days

For example

If the snow day occurs on a Tuesday (B Day)

1. A Day students will engage in Daily Tasks as per their typical schedule
2. B Day students will engage in online learning, via Teams, utilizing the Wednesday online learning schedule.

Late Start

Remote students will begin class at the late start time.

Hybrid

1. In person students will begin school at the late start time.
2. At home learning students will enter attendance and do Daily Tasks by the late start time.

MJH

We will teach lessons as planned for the week whether it is a snow day or not. On a snow day, we will follow the Wednesday shortened remote day schedule that we have used all year where class is in session from 8:00-11:55 a.m. For example: If the snow day is on an A-day, the A-day students will have lessons that were planned, only on a shortened schedule. B-day students will do homework/Daily Tasks as usual.

If it is a late start day, or an early dismissal day, we would follow the schedules for late start or early dismissal and teach lessons as planned at the beginning of the week.

MHS

The high school will conduct online classes, following the schedule below. This is the same schedule we have used on Wednesdays and during our remote only phase from November 18 through January 15. All students, Hybrid A, Hybrid B, and Remote Only students will participate in classes via Teams on “snow days.”
