**REGISTRATION FEES** – If you are paying registration fees on a Payment Schedule, the first payment was due October 5, 2020; the second payment is due January 5, 2021; and the third payment will be due March 1, 2021. If fee payments are delinquent and no attempt is made to pay or make arrangements for payment by March 1, 2021, delinquent fees will be turned over for legal action.

**DENTAL EXAMINATIONS REQUIRED** - The Illinois Department of Public Health requires that a dental examination be completed before May 15, 2021 for children in Kindergarten, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, and 9<sup>th</sup> grades. If you are unable to obtain a dental exam for your student, please complete the waiver form and return it to school. Forms are available on the District website. Students in these grades MUST have the examination or the waiver on file at school before May 15, 2021.

**FAMILY ACCESS INFORMATION** – Parents may view student information on Family Access, a secure website offered by Macomb CUSD#185. If you need a Family Access log in and password, you must contact the Edison School Office.

**SKYWARD MOBILE ACCESS** – Free for any Skyward user – Administrator, Teacher, Parent, or Student. You now have access to your information anywhere you go! Check students' grades and attendance records; view student schedule information; find food service information. This is compatible with most mobile devices, including iOS, Android, Blackberry, and Windows Mobile. Apps may be located at iTunes, Google Play, and/or Amazon Appstore.

**SCHOOL REPORT CARD** – Edison's School Report Card and the District Report Card are posted on the school and District websites. Go to <http://www.macomb185.org> and click on the Parents/Students menu to select School Report Cards. Anyone who wishes to have a hard copy of the Edison School or District Report Card can request one from our office by calling 309-837-3993.



**SNOW DAY PROCEDURES** – This year when a snow day occurs, we will have school remotely. There will be no in person attendance.

If a snow day occurs on an A Day (Monday or Thursday), students that would normally go to school will join their teacher on Teams by 8:00 a.m. While the B Day student would take their attendance and complete daily tasks.

If a snow day occurs on a Hybrid B Day (Tuesday or Friday), students that would normally go to school will join their teacher on Teams by 8:00 a.m. While the A Day student would take their attendance and complete their daily tasks.

If a snow day occurs on a Wednesday, the regular remote learning schedule would stay the same as always. No changes would be made to the Wednesday schedule.

Remote Only students will have a normal day and log in with their teachers as they normally would.

**LATE START** – Remote students would start at the late start time, In person students would start at the late start time. At home learning students will enter attendance and begin daily tasks at the late start time.

**WEATHER RELATED DISMISSALS** – Please make plans with your children now for weather-related early dismissal days. We will be unable to handle the hundreds of phone messages that may come in, so prior planning will assure your children of what to do in case of an emergency school closing. Also, remind your children to dress warmly for outdoor recess activities (hat, gloves, coat, boots). Please listen to the following radio/tv stations for a school cancellation report: WJEQ-FM 102.7, WKAI-FM 100.0, WIUM-FM 91.3, KHQA-TV and WGEM-TV. If the weather becomes questionable during the day, please listen to your radio for cancellation of school, games or practices. The Skylert system will contact parents/guardians at all numbers provided with information on school closings/early dismissals.

**NOTE FROM THE DISTRICT NURSE** – - Please call the school office (837-3993) by 9:00 a.m., if your child will be absent from either online or in person learning. When calling please be sure to let the office know your student's symptoms. If anyone in your family is experiencing fever, chills, cough, shortness of breath, fatigue, loss of taste or smell, body aches, headaches, sore throat, congestion, runny nose, abdominal pain, nausea, vomiting or diarrhea, please keep all of your children home. If your child is sick and not coming to school, you will need to be sure any sibling is kept home as well. If your student is ill and not able to come to school, they can still login on laptops, take attendance and work on their daily tasks to keep up with what they will be missing while not at school.
